PUBLIC MEETING TUESDAY, JANUARY 24TH

The Cascade Locks City Council has called for the community meeting to solicit community suggestions and ideas to be used in the development of the 2012-13 City Budget. The purpose of the meetings are to 1) provide citizens with the opportunity to tell the Council how citizens think tax money should be spent; 2) what services they want the City to provide and; 3) what the priorities should be.

The meetings will be facilitated by city staff and participating citizens will be asked to respond to the three questions. All of the ideas will be taken under advisement by the Council and Budget Committee in developing the 2012-13 budget. Refreshments will be served at the meetings and all citizens are encouraged to attend and participate.
